









Students

- In July over **1,500 students** celebrated their Congregation, joining our alumni community in **160 countries** across the globe.
- Our campaign Forever Forward is London Business School's ambitious £200 million fundraising drive, set to amplify our global impact and transform the future. We have already inspired £37.49 million in gifts solely for our scholarship pillar. We are currently at £81.28m towards our goal of £200m in the next five years.
- Work has begun to transform the Plowden Building into a vibrant, 24/7 accessible space for students and alumni, promoting collaboration, development and wellbeing. - Sergei Guriev was appointed Dean in August 2024, after moving from his senior position at the prestigious Sciences Po in Paris, known for educating the French political elite, including the last five Presidents of France. He also joins the distinguished LBS faculty as a Professor of Economics.





- In January 2024, **Emily Robin** was appointed the new Associate Dean for Advancement. She joined LBS from INSEAD, where she was the Senior Director of Development in the Advancement team. The Associate Dean for Advancement works closely with the Dean to serve the School's global network of alumni, creating value for the community and inspiring philanthropic giving to the School's major fundraising campaign, Forever Forward.
- Our MBA programme has re-entered the FT's top 10, climbing eight places to rank eighth in the Financial Times Global MBA Ranking. It also ranks joint fourth worldwide for Aims Achieved at 91%, reflecting how well the programme helps students meet their goals.
- The Masters in Finance (MiF) Programme has been ranked as the world's best in the latest Financial Times (FT) MiF ranking.
- EMBA and EMBA Global programmes are in the top five positions in the latest rankings of the world's best EMBAs by Quacquarelli Symonds.

- Our faculty continues to attract **prestigious awards**. Professors Alex Edmans and Elias Papaioannou have been awarded Fellowships to the British Academy the UK's national academy for the social sciences and humanities.
