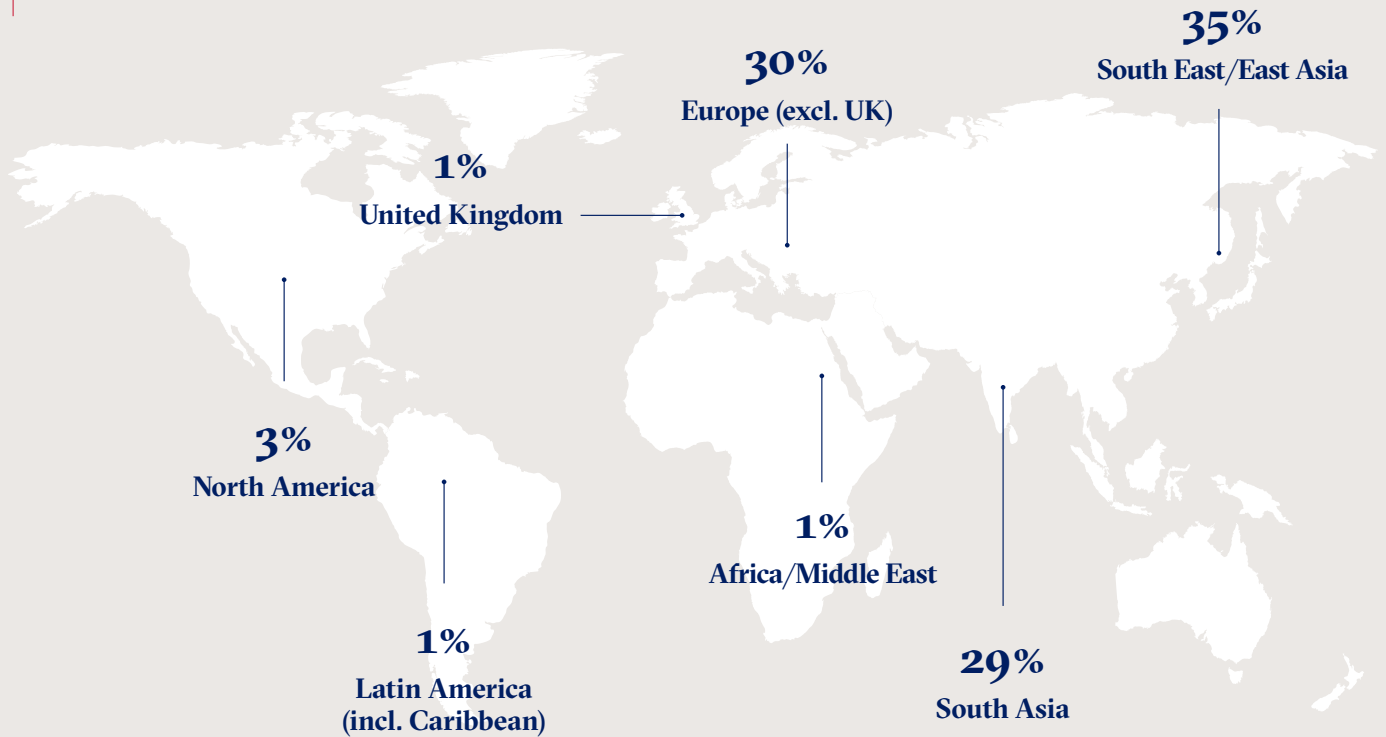

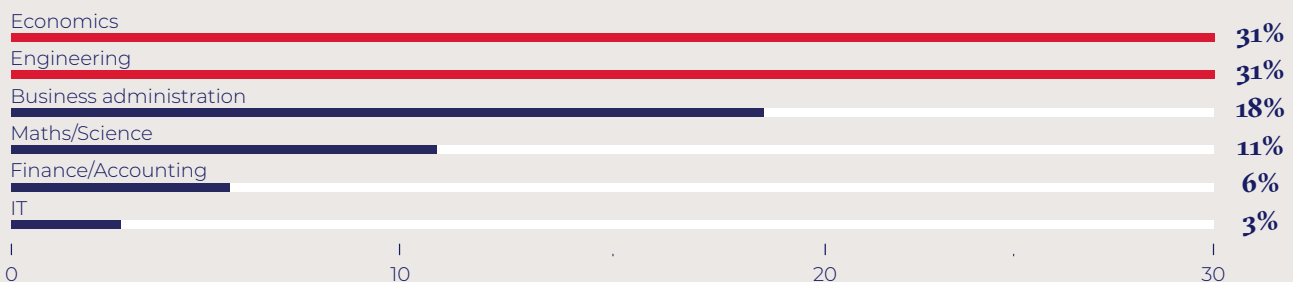

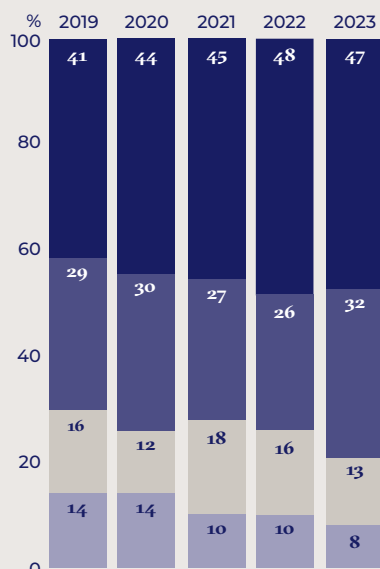


Undergraduate study discipline

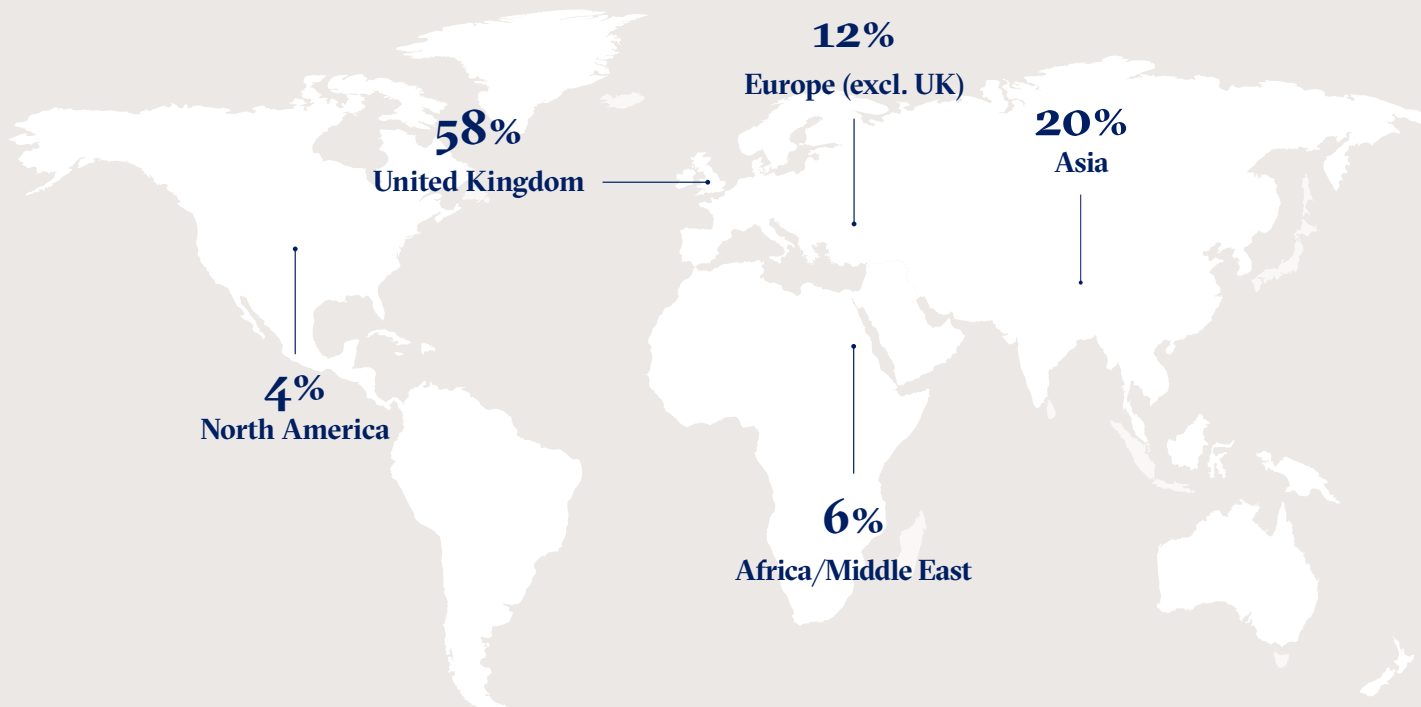

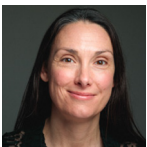

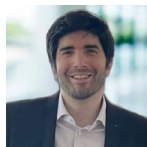

The Career Centre comprises 45 permanent staff, most of whom have real-world coaching and commercial experience to help students achieve their career goals. Team members include:



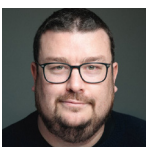

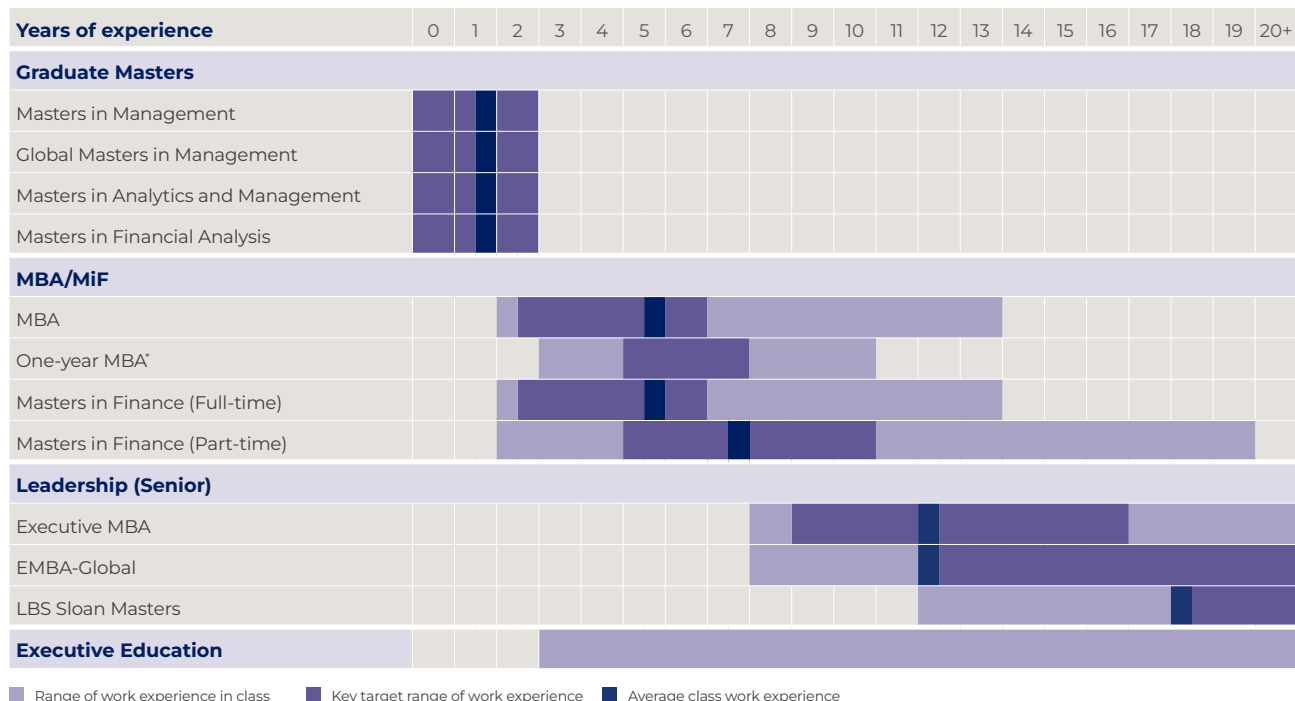
