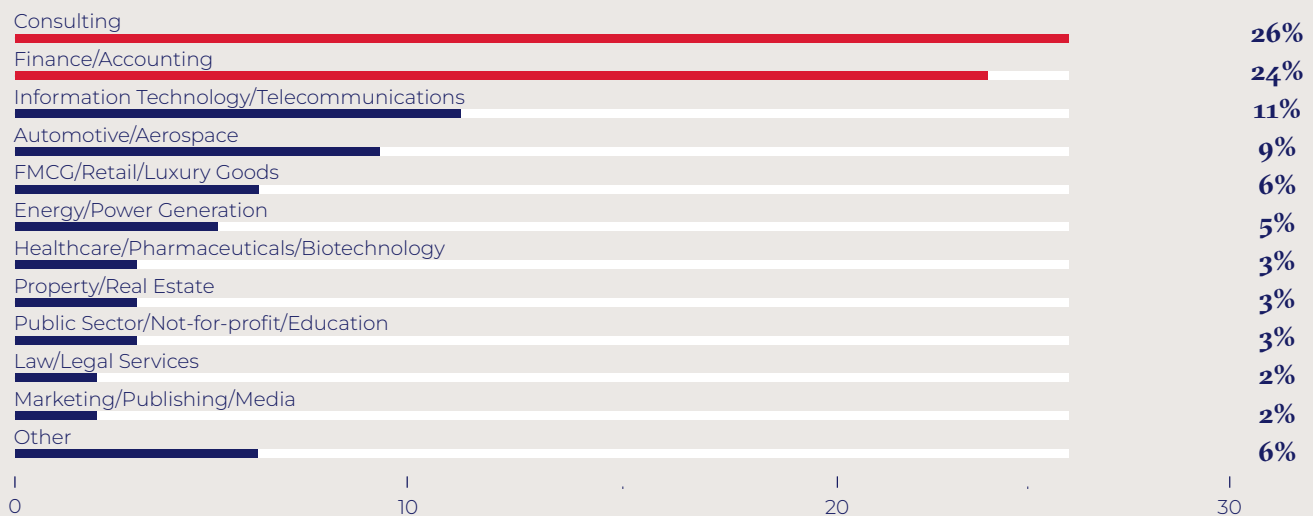

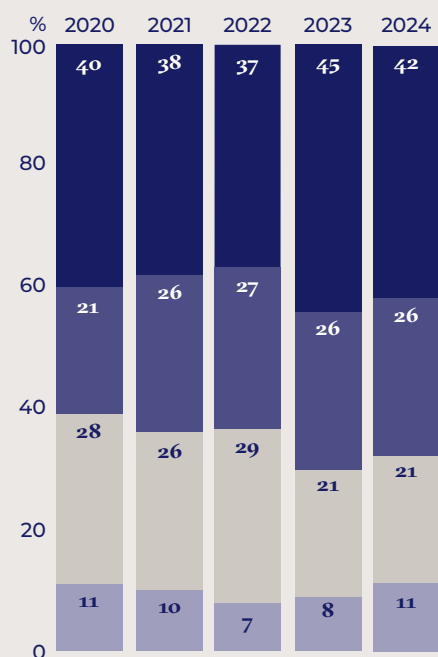

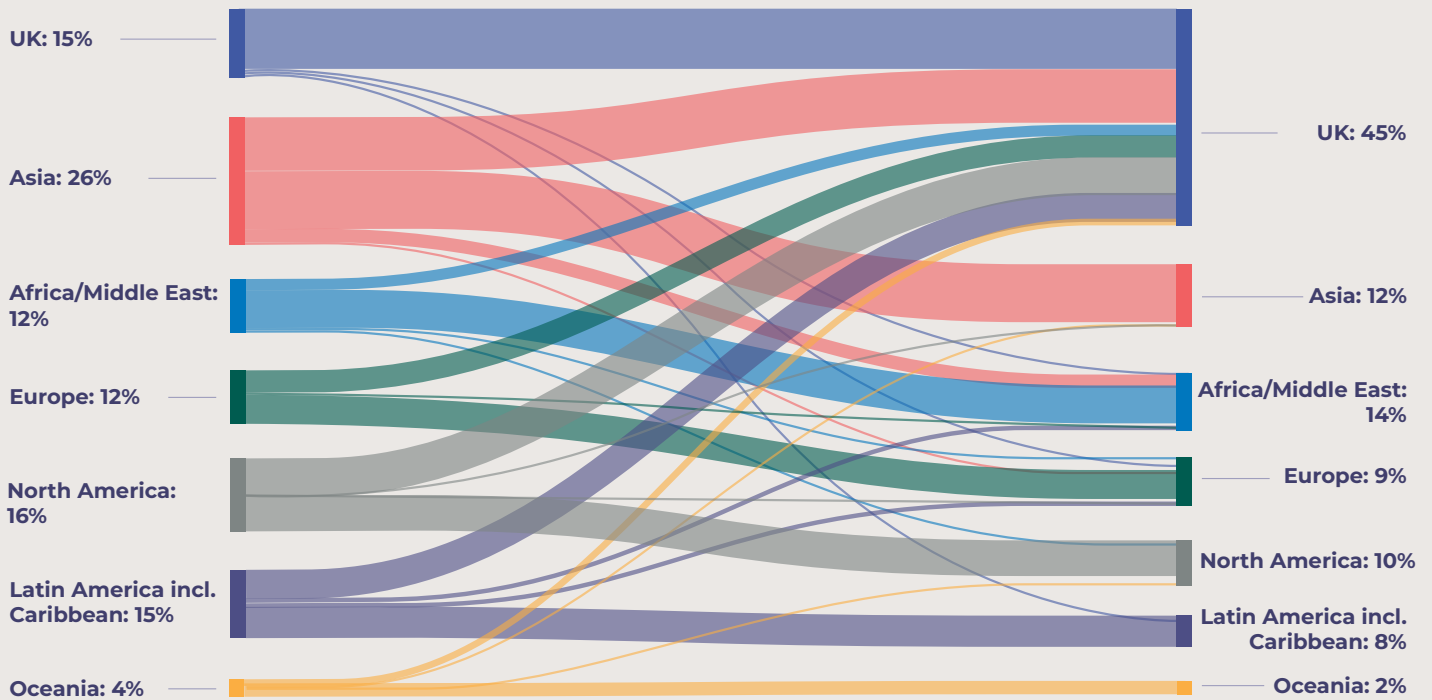

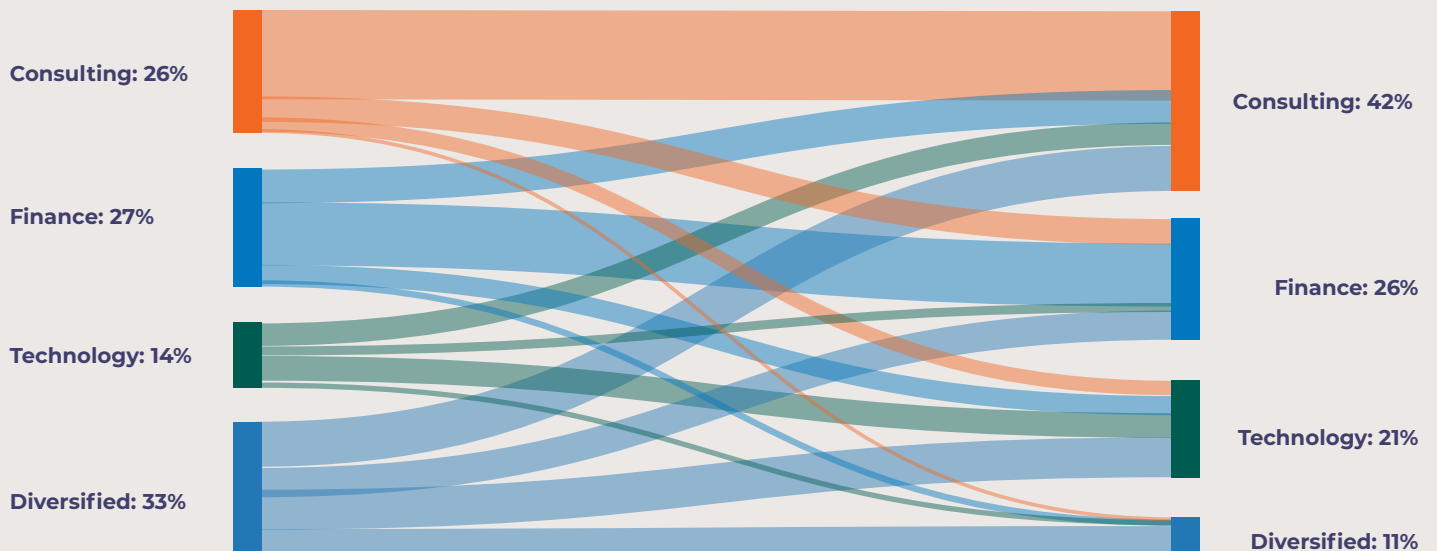

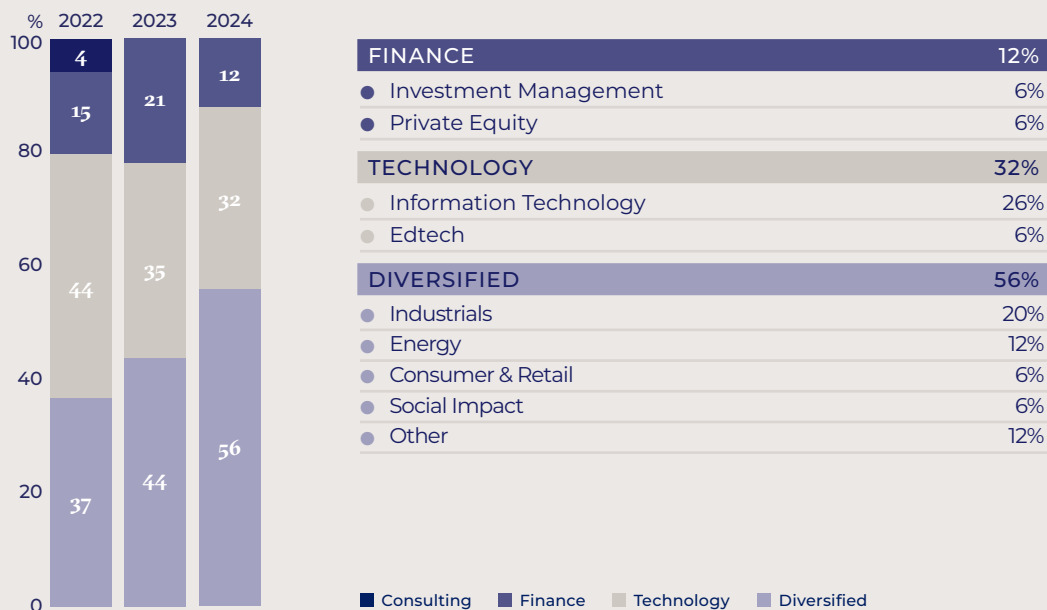
Entrepreneurs

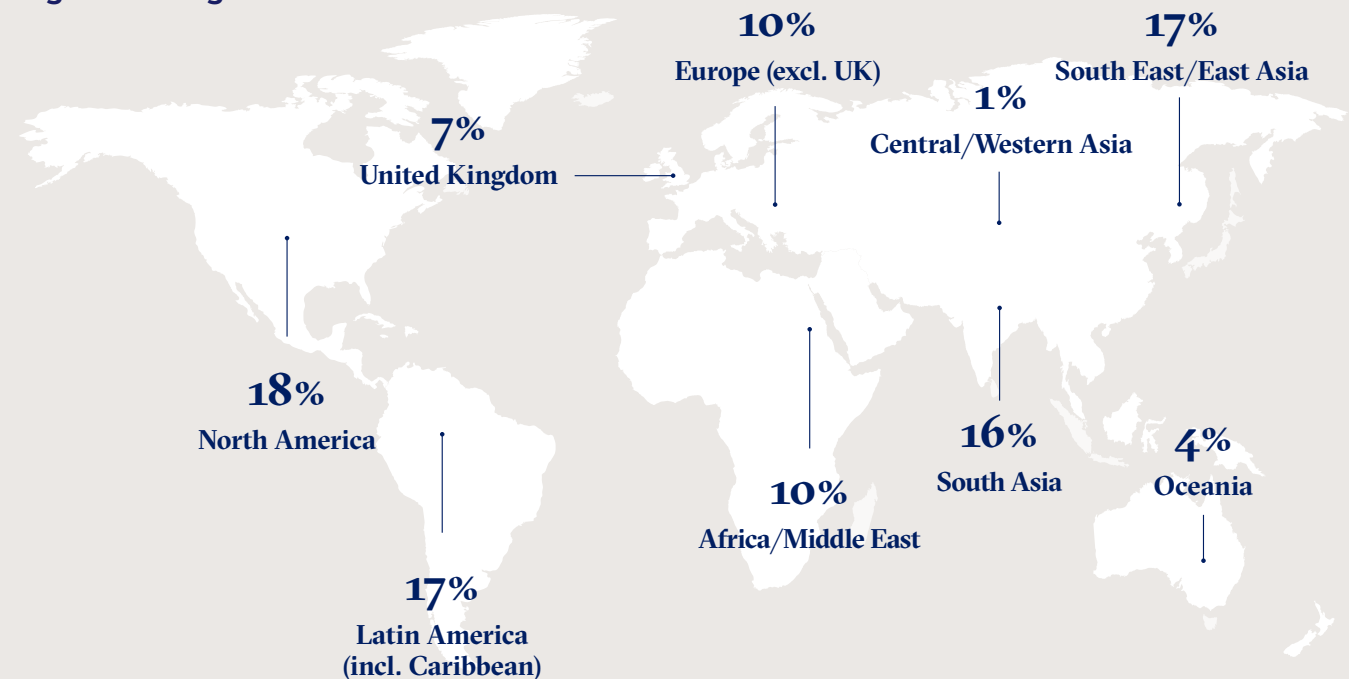

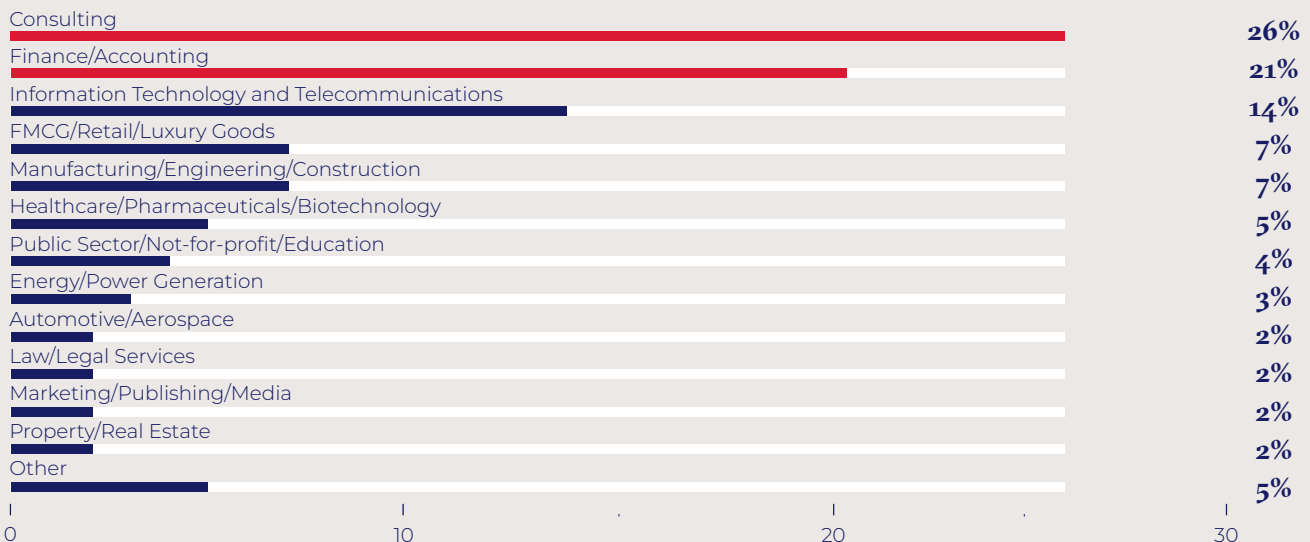
MBA2025 class profile

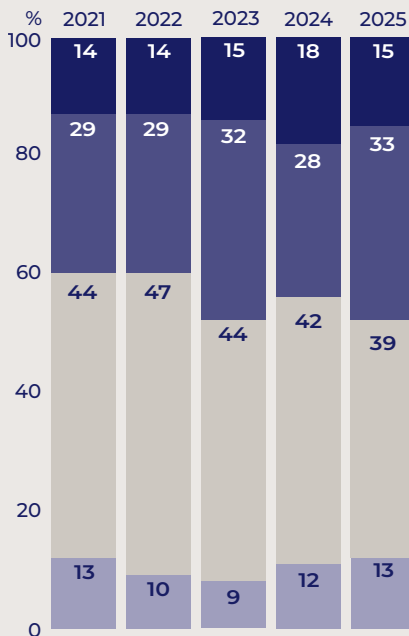

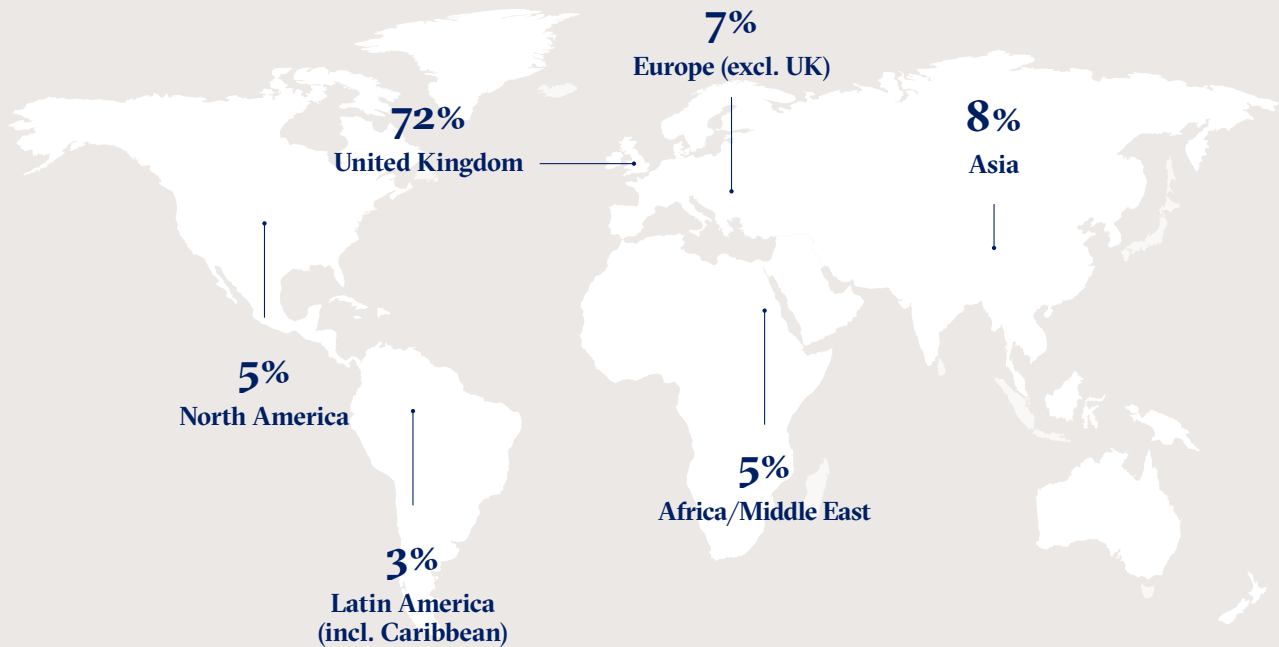

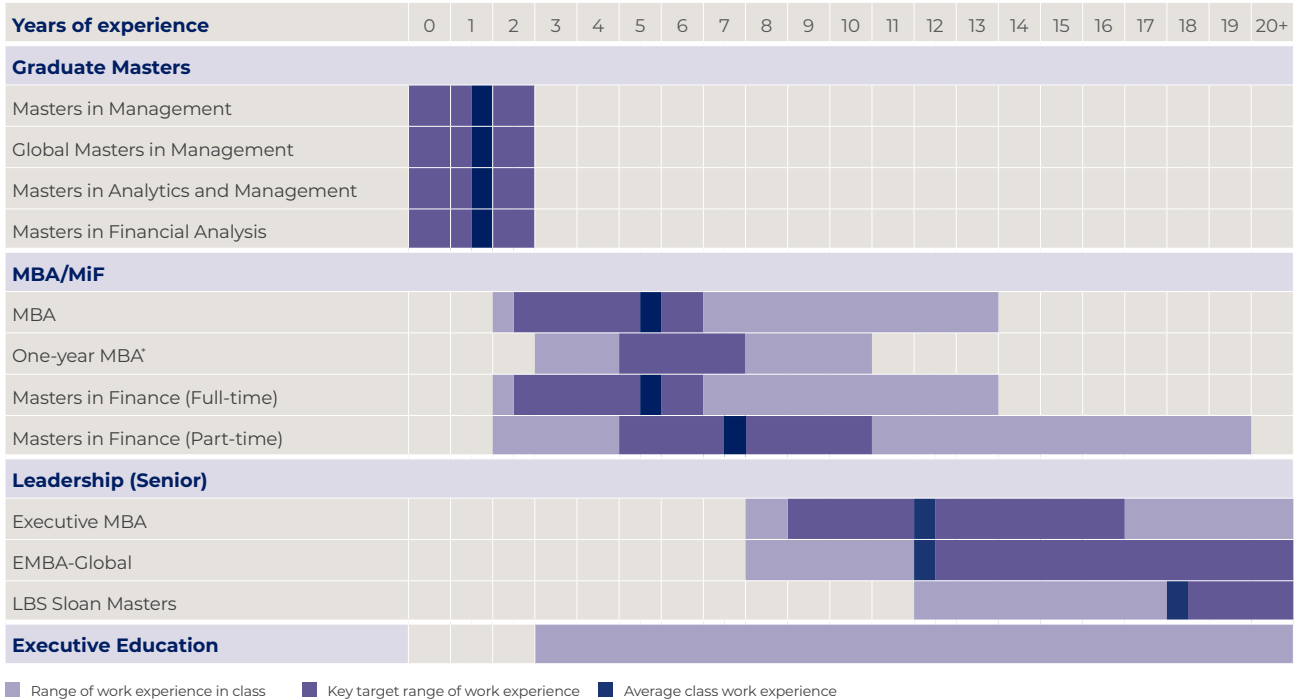
