

Late applications to the One-year MBA programme commencing in August 2026.

Although the formal application deadline for the August 2026 intake has now passed, we continue to welcome late applications from outstanding candidates for the One-year MBA. We recognise that sometimes opportunities for study come at unexpected times, so we remain open to considering exceptional individuals outside the standard cycle.

Candidates who meet the programme pre-requisites and have all required documentation prepared are encouraged to submit a complete application for consideration. If you are uncertain about your eligibility, or if your documentation is not yet finalised, we invite you to contact us for initial guidance.

Please email your request to oneyearmba@london.edu, titled Late Application Request, with the below information:

- One-page CV
- Transcripts from your previous master's in management or equivalent degree. This must be from an accredited institution (AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA, Russell Group or University of London institution)
- Your nationality and country of residence
- Short paragraph detailing your post One-year MBA aspirations
- The date of your scheduled GMAT/GRE/EA test *or* your GMAT/GRE/EA test score if already taken
- Date of your scheduled English test *or* your English test score if already taken (if applicable, please see [here](#) for details)

If you are submitting a late application, you will need to ensure that you can satisfy each of the following criteria:

- Whilst there can be flexibility with receiving a test score, no offer of admission will be made without a test score. You should be prepared to sit a test before you submit your application or shortly after.
- You must be able to leave your current employment in time for the start of the programme, which is planned for 10 August 2026.
- If we make you an offer, you must be prepared to make initial fee payments (totaling GBP 10,000) shortly after the offer. If you require a student visa to study in the UK, this is also one of the conditions to obtain your CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies) which is required for the [Student visa](#) application. Please note that you will need to have your funding in place as scholarships are rarely available at this point of the admissions cycle.

We will not be allowing deferrals for late applicants, so it is imperative that you are ready and committed to start the One-year MBA programme this year if you are considering a late application.

Applications for the August 2027 intake are due to open in August 2026.

We expect the application deadlines to be similar to the 25/26 year and the essays to be unchanged.
