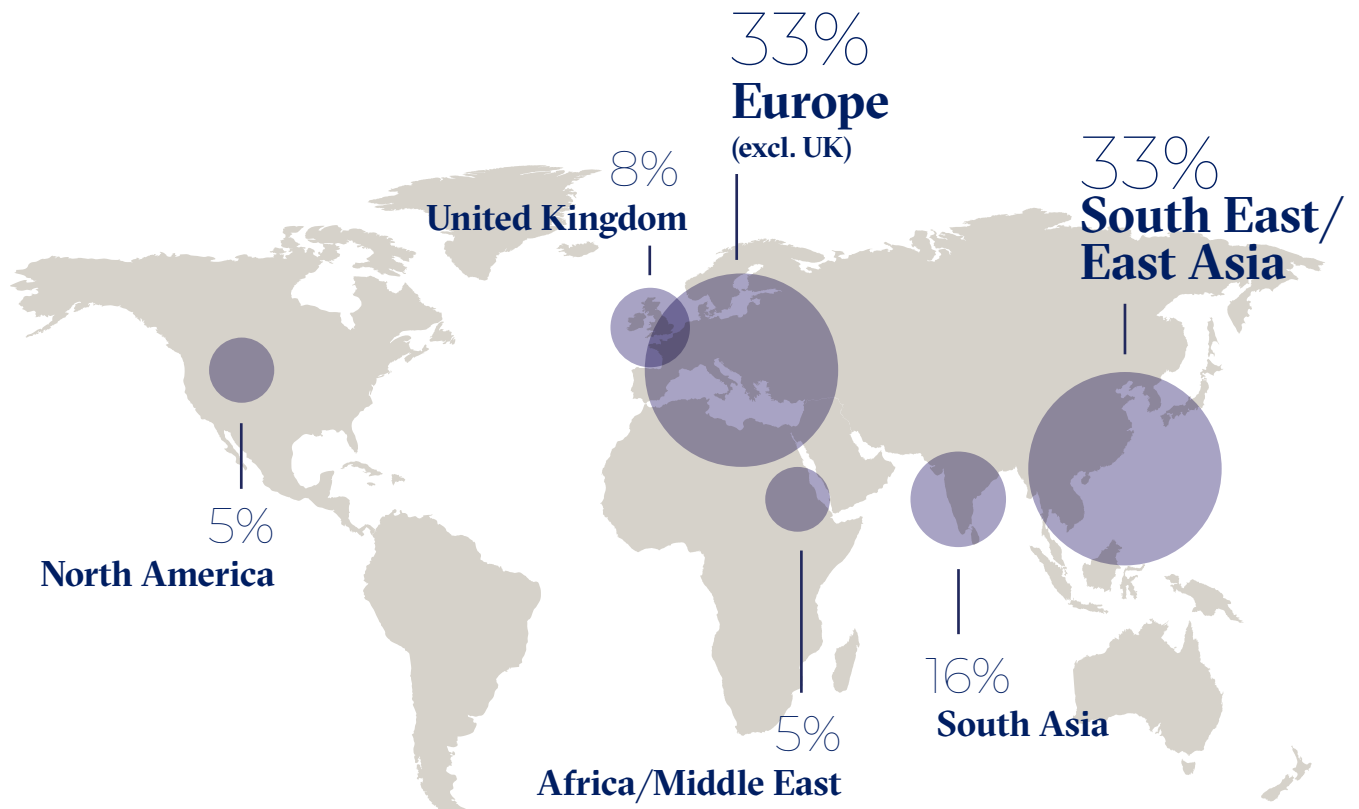

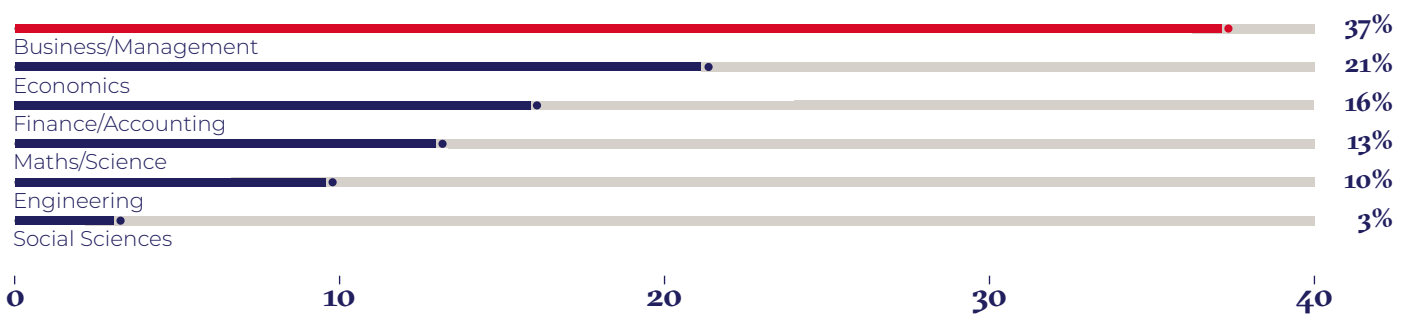
Class profile

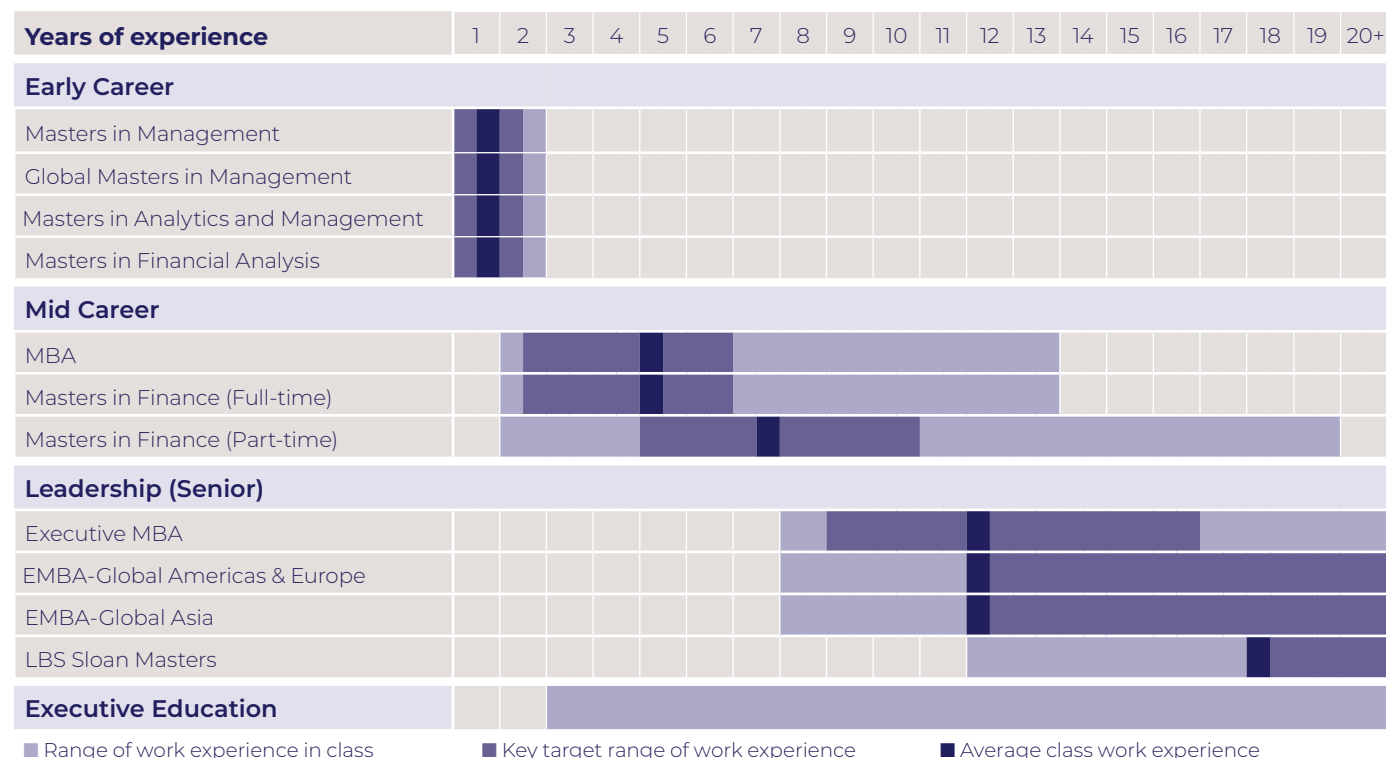
