

### **Late applications to the Full-time MBA (15-21 month duration) commencing in August 2026**

Although formal application deadlines for the August 2026 intake have now passed, we are accepting late applications on a case-by-case basis. We recognise that sometimes opportunities for study come at unexpected times, so we ensure that we provide opportunities for off-schedule consideration.

If you wish to be considered for a late application, please email your request to [mba@london.edu](mailto:mba@london.edu), titled Late Application Request, with the below information:

- One-page CV
- Your nationality and country of residence
- Short paragraph detailing your post-MBA aspirations
- The date of your scheduled GMAT/ GRE test *or* your GMAT/GRE test score if already taken
- Date of your scheduled English test *or* your English test score if already taken (if applicable, please see [here](#) for details)

We will then be able to consider your request for a late application. Please note: late applications are not automatically permitted, and as stated above, they are considered on a case-by-case basis by the Admissions Committee.

If you are approved to submit a late application by the Admissions Committee, you will need to ensure that you can satisfy each of the following criteria:

- Whilst there can be flexibility with receiving a GMAT/GRE test score, no offer of admission will be made without a test score. You should be prepared to sit a test before you submit your application or shortly after.
- You must be able to leave your current employment in time for the start of the programme, which is planned for 10 August 2026.
- If we make you an offer, you must be prepared to make initial fee payments (totaling GBP 10,000) shortly after the offer. If you require a student visa to study in the UK, this is also one of the conditions to obtain your CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies) which is required for the [Student visa](#) application. Please note that you will need to have your funding in place as scholarships are rarely available at this point of the admissions cycle.

**We will not be allowing deferrals for late applicants, so it is imperative that you are ready and committed to start the MBA programme this year if you are considering a late application.**

Applications for the August 2027 intake are due to open in August 2026.

We expect the application deadlines to be similar to the 25/26 year and the essays to be unchanged.
